GENERAL DESCRIPTION:

The Relief Maintenance Worker, reporting to the Facilities Manager and working out of the 349 Ontario Street location, is responsible for cleaning and maintenance, ensuring safe and healthy operation of the building, and responding to emergencies as required and necessary.

MAJOR DUTIES:

- Overall maintenance and cleaning of the building, including but not limited to mopping, sanitizing of toilets/urinals, sinks, showers, tabletops, sweeping, vacuuming of various rooms and offices, Maintaining sufficient inventory of supplies, snow removal as well as periodic washing of walls.
- Moving supplies, assisting with receiving shipments.
- Ensure a secure building and a clean, safe and healthy work environment.
