**GENERAL DESCRIPTION:**

Central Neighbourhood House is currently seeking experienced Junior Camp Counselors for its Summer Day Camp Program. Counselors will work in consultation with the Summer Camp Coordinator and Manager, and in cooperation with other Summer Day Camp Staff to ensure a high quality summer camp program for children 5 - 13 years of age.

**MAJOR DUTIES:**

- Assist with supervising children in the summer camp.
- Provide a stimulating, fun and creative program based on children's needs with sensitivity to the diverse ethno-cultural backgrounds of each group.
- Form positive relationships with the children, which includes working with the participants in each program as a group while remaining aware of each individual's needs.
- Participate in providing input into the summer camp planning.
- Be a role model for the program and demonstrate superior leadership skills.
- Demonstrate ability to work in harmony with team members.
- Other duties as assigned.

**REQUIREMENTS & QUALIFICATIONS:**

- Previous program planning and implementation experience working with children aged 5 - 13 in a summer camp or similar program.
- Experience in instruction and programming for children in at least two of the following areas: music (vocal and instrumental), drama and visual art, sports and cooperative games, computers (educational programs and introduction to internet safety), arts and crafts, baking and cooking, environmental awareness.

- Demonstrated communication skills in English; a second language would be an asset.
- Must be available the week of **June 25 - 29, 2018** to attend mandatory training prior to the camp.
- Commitment to anti-oppression principles and experience working with diverse cultures and communities.
- **MUST** be punctual and reliable (arriving at work on time, consistently and prepared for the day).
- **MUST** be able to swim.
- Must be able to work in a diverse and multicultural environment.
