### **Akwasti Worker- Summer Student position**

#### **GENERAL DESCRIPTION:**

This is a 8-week 30 hours per week summer student contract position reporting to the Senior Manager, Community Support. The student will gain experience working with frail, vulnerable and isolated elderly clients by working directly with the Akwasti Convener to help support our clients to live in their own homes as long as possible.

#### **MAJOR DUTIES:**

- Escorts to medical and non-medical appointments
- Home visits, friendly visiting and shopping assistance
- Assisting with client assessments and reassessments using the InterRAI CHA tool
- Entering and documenting data accurately
- Working with volunteers
- Attending team meetings
- Providing administrative support
- Other tasks, relevant to the position as directed by the Senior Manager, Community Support
- Perform other duties, appropriate to the position, as required

#### **REQUIREMENTS & QUALIFICATIONS:**

- This position requires that the student be pursuing education in a related field of study from a Post-Secondary Institution (Community College, Technical Institute or University,) preferably from one of the following programs:
  - Social Services, Social Work and Community Worker programs

To be eligible, students must:

- Be between 15 and 30 years of age at the start of employment
- Have been registered as a full time post-secondary student in the preceding academic year, and intend to return to full time studies in the next academic year
- Be a Canadian citizen, permanent resident or person to whom refugee status has been conferred under the Immigration and Refugee Protection Act and;
- Be legally entitled to work in Canada in accordance with relevant legislation and regulations
