GENERAL DESCRIPTION:

This is a 8-week 30 hours per week summer student contract position reporting to the Senior Manager, Programs & Services, NLSS. The student will work with the Action for Neighbourhood Change (ANC) initiative assisting with implementing and facilitating the program as well as community outreach.

MAJOR DUTIES:

- Assist with organizing, scheduling and facilitating resident meetings, workshops, focus groups, information sessions, open houses, forums and community events
- Sit with resident groups to strategize engagement and community development opportunities
- Assist with facilitation of the resident safety committee
- Assist with recruiting community volunteers
- Assist with the facilitation of the resident safety committee
- Assist with recruiting community volunteers
- Assist with the preparation of schedules, timesheets, and other reports required by the project in a timely manner
- Perform other duties, appropriate to the position, as required

REQUIREMENTS & QUALIFICATIONS:

- This position requires that the student be pursuing education in a related field of study from a Post-Secondary Institution (Community College, Technical Institute or University,) preferably from one of the following programs:
 - Social Services, Social Work or Community Service programs
- Fluency in a second language, especially Mandarin, Cantonese, Urdu, Hindi or Bengali would be an asset

To be eligible, students must:

- Be between 15 and 30 years of age at the start of employment
- Have been registered as a full time post-secondary student in the preceding academic year, and intend to return to full time studies in the next academic year
- Be a Canadian citizen, permanent resident or person to whom refugee status has been conferred under the Immigration and Refugee Protection Act and;
- Be legally entitled to work in Canada in accordance with relevant legislation and regulations
