Reporting to the Senior Manager, Childcare Services. The Early Childhood Educator will plan and implement a program for the children working in a team environment and in accordance with the CCEYE.

MAJOR DUTIES:

- Plan and implement a stimulating and creative program, based on children's needs with sensitivity to the diverse ethno-cultural backgrounds of the children.
- Form positive relationships with each child, observing and recording the child's development and behaviour.
